⁶ Otherwise known as Company G, of the 11th Mississippi Infantry, the Lamar Rifles were gathered from Lafayette County, MS. The regiment was formally organized May 4, 1861 and transported to Lynchburg, Va., where it was mustered in the provisional army for one year by Major Clay on May 13, and on the 19th they arrived at Harper's Ferry. “The Inspector-General reported from Harper's Ferry May 23 that the Mississippians were clamoring for rifles in place of the old muskets they had. The Eleventh, he said, took pride in its appearance and was soldierly.”
