Dear Dr. Clark:


I understand that Fuller Seminary is writing to Christianity Today stating that your report in the May 11 issue is grossly inaccurate and deliberately gives a wrong impression of what Dr. Carnell said. They are particularly perturbed about your quote from Carnell page 36, column 1 "This is a problem for me, too". They are accusing you of making Dr. Carnell pull to Barth's position.

However, I have written to Wilbur Smith and indicated that I was at this same session on April 26, 8:00 p.m., where this question with its appended statement was made by Carnell. I was seated in a choice place, heard well and listened carefully and I am in hearty agreement with your responsible reporting. I heard what you heard.

Obviously, Carnell has himself in trouble with what he said at Rockefeller Chapel. I understand that he white-washed this at a chapel gathering at Fuller Seminary. This is a strange man who suits his theology to the campus where he happens to be making his remarks.

I did not know if you had yet heard from Christianity Today, but you probably will. Thought I would drop you this note.


